**FUSTA MW 14
HIGHLAND DANCE
COMPETITION RULES**

1. All judges decisions are final.
2. Dancers may compete in one section only.
3. Age applies as of May 18, 2013. Proof of age must be furnished if requested.
4. All dancers must present a registration card to compete. If you do not have one, contact your appropriate FUSTA representative.
5. Age groups will be determined according to number of entries.
6. A trophy will be awarded to the highest point winner in each age group. Points will be awarded as follows:
 - 1st -88 points
 - 2nd -56 points
 - 3rd -38 points
 - 4th -25 points
7. Any competitor not ready to perform when their number is called will be disqualified for that dance.
8. No medals will be worn during competition.
9. St. Andrews Society of Central Illinois reserves the right to add or remove events from the schedule and to make other changes as long as its action is within the scope of the Scottish Official Board of Highland Dancing rules and, in the judgment of the committee, is in the best interest of the competition.
10. Competitors will remain in costume until all medals and trophies have been awarded.
11. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by remittance.
12. Dancers entering the competition first will dance last.
13. Medals will be awarded in each event except Premier 16 and over. Cash will be awarded in Premier 16 and over category.

ENTRY DEADLINE: Entry must be received by **May 11, 2013**. **NOTE:** No gate pass will be sent. Name will be on participant list at front gate. Be sure to circle each event you are entering in the next column.
